Meeting News

Our guest on October 11 was David Kearn, who shared his methods for painting portraits in watercolour. Working on 140-pound Arches hot press paper mounted on an almost upright easel, David began a likeness of well-known author Margaret Atwood by laying down very light washes of burnt sienna and ultramarine blue, explaining that his preference was to apply pigments that could be "lifted" as compared to pigments that stain. This way, he was able to

lift pigment from the highlighted areas of the face and eyes. With a deft brush for details and a keen eye, David was able to continue his painting, producing the finished result—not an exact likeness but an unmistakable portrait of his subject.

The guest speaker for January 2012 will be announced at a later date.
