much of their business was in poster framing. The last few years have seen a greater interest in original art, including local art. Oil and acrylics are more popular than other art forms, and there is a trend towards landscapes and florals.

Edward shared much useful information for artists looking to associate themselves with a gallery. He explained the submission process (email only), and how they evaluate the art. It is expected the artist will do their own research to make sure the gallery is a good fit for their art. Many of the gallery's expectations are based in common sense. For example, the works must be finished before they can be submitted – no wet paint! This talk was well received by the audience. Many thanks to Edward for his comprehensive, detailed presentation.
