We have incorporated a lot of changes suggested by our members and if you have any further suggestions to improve the site, we'd like to hear from you. We do have some legacy issues from the old website, namely the Gallery. At this point in time, if you click on the Gallery tab, you will see the gallery on the old website, not the new showcases. This is in the process of being addressed.

The old website will remain in existence in a static mode until all of the current Gallery Members have created their gallery showcase on the new website. With the launch of the new website, all OAA Members are now entitled to a free Gallery Showcase with up to 10 images in it. If a member wishes to retain more than the 10 images, an additional 30 images can be made available at an annual cost of \$30.00. To get started on your new Gallery Showcase, simply register online using the "Complimentary Gallery" form available under the new "Forms" tab and your account and initial password will be emailed to you. We are also realigning the expiry dates of the Gallery subscriptions to coincide with the OAA membership expiry date. Each existing Gallery member will be receiving an email message in the coming days outlining the options available to them.

BOARD OF DIRECTOR DUTIES FOR VACANT POSITIONS
