Summary of Spring 2016 Survey Results

We are grateful to all of you who participated in the web-survey managed by Pat Hendry. The primary purpose of the survey was to find a reason for the gradual drop in attendance at OAA monthly meetings and to determine if anything could be done to reverse this trend. Recruiting members for leadership roles is another concern that needs to be addressed. The results, collated by Pat, provided valuable feedback and prompted us to bring about some immediate changes. Decisions were made to move our meetings to the Sandy Hill Community Centre (250 Somerset Street East), to form a two-person team that has already established a solid program for the coming year, and to send email reminders of upcoming meetings-presentations. Key points and common themes that came to light are summarized in a separate document attached to this email, which we encourage you to review.

Experience the work of one of Mexico's masters, Rufino Tamayo (1899–1991). An independent artist who embraced modernity, Tamayo's style veered from his early depictions of indigenous peoples to playful, colourful, abstract – and sometimes surrealist – later works. Throughout all of his artistic explorations, he remained focused on finding humanity's place in the universe.

Featuring prints and paintings from the collections of the National Institute of Fine Arts, Mexico, as well as an outstanding watercolour from the national collection, this exhibition marks the 25th anniversary of Tamayo's death.
